The Story of the Bible

- 1. Covers from the beginning of Creation until the beginning of the new Creation
 - "Declaring the end from the beginning..." Isaiah 46:10
- 2. Primarily shows God's dealings with man and man's dealings with God & each other
 - "Lo, all these things worketh God oftentimes with man."
 Job 33:29; (Psalm 90:3)
- 3. Ultimate Purpose is to Reveal Jesus Christ (so that man can be reconciled to God)
 - "Search the scriptures... they are they which testify of ME."
 John 5:39; (2 Timothy 3:15)

The Book: "The Bible"

1. A compilation of 66 books.

- About 43 different human authors (all men of Israel except Luke)
- 39 books in the Old Testament; 27 books in the New Testament
- 1189 chapters (929 in OT; 260 in NT) (Psalm 117 = Middle Chapter)
- 31102 Verses (Psalm 103:1-2 = 2 Middle Verses)


2. Written over a period of about 2000 years

- First book written was Job, written around 1900 BC
- Last book written was Revelation, written around 95AD

3. Covers about 7000 years of Man on Earth

- Creation begins around 4000 BC. (Skips 400 years before Christ)
- Then, about 2000 years of Church Age. (Skips about 1900 years)
- When Jesus Comes back then another 1000 years until the final judgment; and then the new heaven and new earth.

Breakdown of the Bible

1. Old Testament

- I. 5 Books of Law: Genesis Deuteronomy
- II. 12 Books of History of Israel: Joshua Esther
- III. 5 Books of Wisdom: Job Song of Solomon
- IV. 17 Books of Prophets:
 - a) 5 Major Prophets: Isaiah Daniel
 - b) 12 Minor Prophets: Hosea Malachi

2. New Testament

- I. 4 Books of the Gospel: Matthew John
- II. 1 Book of Church History: Acts
- III. 21 Letters/Epistles:
 - a) Paul's Epistles: Romans Hebrews
 - b) Other Epistles: James Jude
- IV. 1 Book of Prophecy: Revelation"

A Few Last Important Things:

1. The Bible is both SIMPLE & COMPLEX

- Shallow & Deep (Ezekiel 47:1-5; ankles, knees, loins, over your head)
- Main things are simple and straightforward enough for a child to get; God's not trying to trick us...
- Deep things are deep and can take years of digging and growing until God unveils.

2. Truth is Knowable

- "But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name." John 20:31
- "But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God." 1 Corinthians 2:10
