# Section II. History of Israel

12 Books of History (Joshua through Esther)

## **Quick Overview:**

- Conquest, and establishment of Israel INSIDE the land!
- The rise of the kingdom of Israel & king David.
- Solomon (David's son), building the temple in Jerusalem.
- The split of the kingdom into 2 parts:
  - Northern Kingdom called Israel w/capital in Samaria.
  - > Southern Kingdom called Judah w/capital of Jerusalem.
- Both kingdoms being conquered and carried off into captivity (the north into Assyria; the south into Babylon)
- God bringing the Jews back after 70 years in captivity to rebuild Jerusalem & the temple.

#### **BEFORE the Kingdom**

#### 6. Joshua

1452 BC - 1424 BC

The conquest of the promised land led by Moses' successor: Joshua; and the dividing up of the land amongst the 12 tribes.

• Key People: God, Joshua, Rahab, Achan, Phinehas, Eleazar, Caleb.

## 7. Judges

1426 BC - 1150 BC

The nation of Israel operating as 12 confederate tribes under various judges and their victories, defeats and oppressions.

 Key People: The LORD, Othniel, Ehud, Deborah, Barak, Gideon, Abimelech, Jephthah, Samson, Micah, the Levite & his concubine.

#### 8. Ruth

1290 BC - 1280 BC

A love story of redemption, 2nd chances, and royal lineage; also a beautiful foreshadow of Christ and his bride.

• Key People: Elimelech, Naomi, Ruth, Boaz.

## **DURING the Kingdom**

#### 9. 1 Samuel

1150 BC - 1054 BC

The end of the rule of the judges; the loss of the ark; the kingdom of SAUL (the 1<sup>st</sup> king anointed by Samuel); his rise & fall; the anointing and growth of David.

 Key People: The LORD, Hannah, Eli, Samuel, Hophni, Phinehas, Saul, Jonathan, David, Michal, Abiathar.

#### 10.2 Samuel

1054 BC - 1015 BC

The kingdom of David (the 2<sup>nd</sup> king anointed by Samuel); his conquests, conflicts, covenant, sins, & family troubles.

Key People: The LORD, David, Joab, Abner, Nathan, Bathsheba, Absalom.

## **11.1** Kings

1015 BC - 899 BC

The kingdom of Solomon; the construction of the temple; the split of Israel into 2 kingdoms (North = Israel; South = Judah); the apostasy of Ahab & Jezebel; the ministry of Elijah the prophet.

 Key People: David, Solomon, Adonijah, Rehoboam, Jereboam, Asa, Ahab, Jezebel, Elijah.

## **DURING the Kingdom**

## **12.2** Kings

899 BC - 561 BC

The ministry of Elisha and the record of the kings of Israel & Judah with the downfall of first the northern kingdom to Assyria and then the southern kingdom to Babylon.

• Key People: The LORD, Elijah, Elisha, Benhadad, Jehu, Jehoash, Hezekiah, Josiah, Nebuchadnezzar.

#### 13.1 Chronicles

4004 BC - 1015 BC

The priests' recorded history of the lineage of the nation of Israel, the lineage of king David, and the kingdom of David.

• Key People: The LORD, David, Joab, Nathan, Solomon.

#### 14.2 Chronicles

1015 BC - 536 BC

The priests' recorded history of the kingdom of Solomon and the southern kingdom of Judah until its carrying off into captivity.

• Key People: God, Solomon, Rehoboam, Abijah, Asa, Jehoshaphat, Athaliah, Jehoiada, Joash, Amaziah, Uzziah, Ahaz, Hezekiah, Manasseh, Josiah.

**AFTER the Kingdom (Captivity & Regathering)** 

**15.** Ezra

538 BC - 432 BC

A remnant of Jews being sent back to Jerusalem to rebuild the temple; their challenges; Ezra re-establishing proper worship.

• Key People: God, Cyrus, Jeshua, Zerubbabel, Artaxerxes, Darius, Ezra.

#### 16. Nehemiah

519 BC - 432 BC

Nehemiah, the governor, is sent back to Jerusalem to rebuild the walls & gates; he overcomes challenges and re-establishes order.

• Key People: God, Nehemiah, Sanballat, Tobiah, Ezra

#### 17. Esther

486 BC - 474 BC

A story of God's protection of his chosen people (the Jews) in captivity; a picture of their future triumph over their enemies.

• Key People: Ahasuerus, Vashti, Mordecai, Esther (Hadassah), Haman, Zeresh.
