Ephesians Notes

Key Points Chapter by Chapter:

Chapter 1:

- 1. Chosen "in HIM" (vs 1-14)
 - a. Blessed with all spiritual blessings ("in heavenly places in Christ").
 - b. Before the foundation of the world.
 - c. Predestinated ----> Adoption of children (to himself, by Jesus Christ)
 - d. Chosen to be holy and without blame before him (in love).
 - e. To the praise of the glory of his grace!
 - f. Accepted in the beloved (Jesus).
 - g. Redemption through his blood ---> forgiveness of sins!
 - h. Predestinated to an inheritance to be gathered into one in Christ.
 - i. Trust in Christ!
 - i. Heard the word of truth (the gospel of salvation)
 - ii. Believed HIM.
 - iii. Sealed with the holy Spirit of Promise!
 - * He is the earnest of our inheritance UNTIL the redemption of the purchased possession (when we get our new body Romans 8:23).
- 2. Prayer for the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him (Christ): So that the EYES of our understanding can be enlightened to know: (vs 15-23)
 - a. The HOPE of his calling.
 - b. The RICHES of the glory of his INHERITANCE (in the saints)
 - c. The EXCEEDING greatness of his POWER ---> to us who believe: God wrought this power in Christ when he:
 - i. Raised him from the dead.
 - ii. Set him at his own right hand (in heavenly places),
 - a) FAR ABOVE:
 - i) All principality
 - ii) All power
 - iii) All might
 - iv) All dominion
 - v) Every name that is named (in this world and the world to come)
 - b) Put ALL THINGS under his feet!
 - c) Gave him to be the HEAD over all things to the church.
 - i) His body
 - ii) The fulness of him that filleth all in all.

Chapter 2:

- 1. We are quickened (vs 1-10)
 - a. We were dead in trespasses and sins
 - i. Used to walk according to the course of THIS world.

- ii. According to the prince of the power of the air (Satan: the spirit that works in the children of disobedience)
- b. But GOD:
 - i. Rich in mercy
 - ii. Loved us greatly
 - iii. Quickened us together WITH Christ.
 - iv. Raised us up TOGETHER into heavenly places in Christ.
 - v. Saved us by his grace through faith.
 - vi. Made us HIS workmanship
 - a) Created in Christ Jesus
 - b) Created unto good works to walk in (before ordained).
- 2. Reconciliation (vs 11-22)
 - a. Time Past:
 - i. Gentiles/Uncircumcision
 - ii. Without Christ:
 - a) Aliens from the commonwealth of Israel
 - b) Strangers from the covenants of promise.
 - iii. No HOPE: Without God in the world
 - b. But NOW:
 - i. Made nigh by the blood of Christ.
 - ii. Christ has broken down the middle wall of partition between us.
 - a) Christ = Our peace (Jews and Gentiles)
 - b) Christ ---> Made Jew and Gentile into 1 New Man.
 - c) Christ abolished the enmity: the law of commandments (contained in ordinances).
 - d) Christ: Has taken that 1 Body (both Jew and Gentile) ---> reconciled to God
 - i) By the cross.
 - ii) By slaying the enmity.
 - e) Christ: Preached peace to BOTH (Jew & Gentile)
 - iii. Standing: Fellowcitizens with the saints and of the household of God! (no more strangers and foreigners)
 - a) Built upon:
 - i) Jesus Christ = the chief cornerstone
 - ii) The apostles & prophets = the foundation of the temple
 - b) This is the Habitation of God:
 - i) Fitly framed together.
 - ii) Growing into a holy temple.
 - iii) We are built together into it.
 - iv) Built through the Spirit.

Chapter 3:

- 1. God's grace dispensed to Paul: (vs 1-13)
 - a. Direct Revelation of the mystery of Christ
 - i. Was not previously known.
 - ii. Now revealed to the holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.
 - iii. That the Gentiles = fellow heirs, be of the same body, and be partakers of his promise (in Christ) by the gospel.
 - b. Ministry of the Mystery:
 - i. According to God's grace.
 - ii. Given by the effectual working of his power.
 - iii. To PREACH among the Gentiles the UNSEARCHABLE riches of Christ.
 - iv. To make all men see the FELLOWSHIP of the mystery.
 - v. To make known the manifold wisdom of God (by the church) to principalities and powers in heavenly places.
 - vi. According to God's eternal purpose in Christ Jesus.
 - vii. Boldness and access with confidence (despite tribulations).
- 2. The ultimate call of the church: ALL GLORY TO GOD! (vs 14-21)
 - a. Bow to the Father (of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named).
 - b. Strengthened with MIGHT!
 - i. According to the RICHES of his glory.
 - ii. By his Spirit.
 - iii. In the INNER MAN.
 - c. Christ to dwell in our hearts (by faith).
 - d. To be rooted and grounded in LOVE.
 - e. To comprehend and KNOW the LOVE of Christ:
 - i. With all saints.
 - ii. The breadth, the length, the depth, and the height of it.
 - iii. It surpasses knowledge.
 - f. Filled with all the fulness of God.
 - g. He is able to do exceeding abundantly ABOVE all we ask or think.
 - h. All glory to God
 - i. in the church.
 - ii. by Christ Jesus.
 - iii. throughout all ages (world without end)!

Chapter 4: Walking worthy of the LORD

- 1. The spirit of the body of Christ: (vs 1-3)
 - a. The Call: To walk worthy of the vocation (calling).
 - b. How:
 - i. With all lowliness and meekness.
 - ii. With all long-suffering: forbearing one another in LOVE.
 - iii. Endeavoring to keep the UNITY of the Spirit in the bond of PEACE.

- 2. Understanding the body (vs 4-16)
 - a. Unity! The 7 "one's"
 - * body, Spirit, hope of calling, Lord, faith, baptism, God and Father of all (above all, through all, in us all)
 - b. Diversity of gifts of Christ (but still united)
 - i. Grace for every one of us
 - ii. Descend before Ascending (even Christ himself...)
 - iii. 4-fold Leadership Gifts (growth cultivators, equippers)
 - * Apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors & teachers.
 - a) 3 practical functions:
 - i) Perfecting of the saints.
 - ii) The work of the ministry.
 - iii) The edifying of the body of Christ.
 - b) 2 goals for the body to come into:
 - i) The unity of the faith.
 - ii) The knowledge of the Son of God.
 - c) 2 goals for the body to come unto:
 - i) A perfect man.
 - ii) The measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ.
 - d) 2 things to "be" from this point forward:
 - i) No more children
 - Tossed to and fro,
 - Carried about with every wind of doctrine,
 - The sleight of man and cunning craftingness to deceive.
 - ii) Growing up into our head (in all things)
 - Speaking the truth in love.
 - From him we are fitly joined together and compacted.
 - According to the effectual working of every part
 - Makes increase of the body ---> edifying of itself in love.
- 3. The life (conduct) of the body (believers): (vs 17-32)
 - a. The Call: Don't walk as the lost Gentiles walk but walk as Christ taught us.
 - b. The Keys:
 - i. Put off the old man (corrupt according to the deceitful lusts)
 - ii. Be renewed (in the spirit of your mind)
 - iii. Put on the new man (which is created after God in righteousness and true holiness).
 - c. The Conduct: Putting off ---> Putting on
 - i. Lying ----> Speak Truth (members one of another)
 - ii. Anger/Wrath ---> Settle it before the sun goes down (don't let it become bitterness and give place to the devil)
 - iii. Stealing ---> Labor with own hands (to provide for those in need)
 - iv. Corrupt Communication ---> Good for edifying.
 - v. Grieve the holy Spirit ---> Listen to him (bless him)

- vi. Bitterness, wrath, anger clamour, evil speaking, malice ---> Kind, tender, forgiving one another (as God forgave us for Christ's sake).
 vii. Fornication, uncleanness, filthiness ---> Walk in love as saints.
- viii.Covetousness, foolish talking, jesting ---> Give Thanks.

Chapter 5: The call to follow God as dear children and to walk in love as Christ loved us and gave himself for us

- 1. Generally in the body of Christ: (vs 1-21)
 - a. Not in Darkness/Children of disobedience:
 - i. Fornication, uncleanness, covetousness not to be named among us.
 - ii. Filthiness, foolish talking, jesting are not convenient.
 - iii. Whoremongerers, unclean persons, covetous men (idolaters) have no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.
 - iv. The wrath of God is to come upon them.
 - v. Don't be partakers with them.
 - b. Children of the kingdom/light
 - i. Must walk a such.
 - ii. Our fruit (of the Spirit) is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth.
 - iii. No fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness.
 - iv. Must reprove the works of darkness.
 - v. Must awake and walk circumspectly/wisely.
 - vi. Must redeem the time (because the days are evil).
 - vii. Must understand what the will of the Lord is.
 - viii.Must be filled with the Spirit (not drunk with wine).
 - ix. Speaking to ourselves in psalms, hymns, & spiritual songs (singing and making melody in our hearts to the Lord).
 - x. Give thanks always for all things.
 - xi. Submit one to another (in the fear of God).
- 2. In the Marriage Relationship
 - a. The Wives:
 - i. Duty: Submit to own husbands and REVERENCE them.
 - ii. Why: The husband is the head of the wife.
 - iii. To what extent: In every thing (just as the church is subject unto Christ).
 - b. The Husbands:
 - i. Duty: To LOVE their wives as themselves.
 - ii. To what extent: As Christ loved the church and gave himself for it.
 - iii. Why: Christ's example
 - a) To sanctify and cleanse it by the word.
 - b) To present it to himself a glorious church.
 - i) Without spot or wrinkle.
 - ii) Holy and without blemish.
 - iv. More work: nourish and cherish her, sanctify, and cleanse her.

- v. Goal: Leave father and mother and be JOINED to his wife ---> Become 1 flesh.
- c. Mystery: Christ and the Church
 - i. We are members of his body, of his flesh, of his bones.

Chapter 6:

- 1. More Relationships: (vs 1-9)
 - a. Children/Parents
 - i. Children: obey parents and honour them
 - a) This is right
 - b) This is the first commandment with promise.
 - ii. Fathers: Don't provoke your children to wrath; bring them up in the nurture and admonition.
 - b. Servant/Master
 - i. Servants: Be obedient
 - a) With fear and trembling.
 - b) In singleness of heart.
 - c) As unto Christ.
 - d) Not with eye service (as men pleasers).
 - e) As the servants of Christ.
 - f) Doing the will of God from the heart.
 - g) With good will (as to the Lord, not unto men).
 - h) Knowing that you will be rewarded of the Lord for any good done.
 - ii. Masters: Treat your servants well without threatening:
 - a) With all the same heart attitudes as the servants above.
 - b) Knowing that your Master in heaven is watching (there is no respect of persons with him).
- 2. Spiritual Warfare: (vs 10-22)
 - a. Be STRONG in the Lord and the POWER of his might.
 - b. Put on the whole armor of God! (to stand against the devil in the battle)
 - i. Belt of TRUTH
 - ii. Breastplate of RIGHTEOUSNESS
 - iii. Shoes of the GOSPEL of PEACE
 - iv. Shield of FAITH (above all)
 - v. Helmet of SALVATION
 - vi. Sword of the SPIRIT (which is the word of God)
 - c. Praying ALWAYS
 - i. Prayer and supplications in the Spirit.
 - ii. Watching with all perseverance & supplication for ALL saints.
 - d. Need Utterance & Boldness
 - i. To make known the mystery of the gospel!
 - e. Know the brethren's affairs & bless and comfort them.
