Key Points Chapter by Chapter:

Chapter 1:

1. Paul's prayer & thanks for the believers

vs 3-11

- a. We see Paul's heart for these believers:
 - 1. Genuine Thanksgiving.
 - 2. Desire for growth, sincerity, purity, & fruitfulness.
- 2. Paul explaining his situation in prison

vs 12-26

- a. The furtherance of the gospel!
- b. Paul's rejoicing!
- c. Paul's strait betwixt two (desire to depart, but more needful to abide in the flesh).
- 3. Paul's admonition

vs 27-30

- a. Conversation should be becoming of the gospel.
- b. It's a gift to suffer for the name of Jesus (follow Paul's example).

Chapter 2: Likemindedness/"Mind of Christ"

1. The call to live it:

vs 1-4

- a. Likeminded: same love, one accord, one mind
- b. Lowliness of mind: No strife or vainglory; esteem others better than self.
- c. Others minded: look on (consider) needs of others.
- 2. Christ's Perfect Example

vs 5-11

- a. Equal with God
- b. Made himself of no reputation: servant, man.
- c. Humbled himself: Obedient to death of cross.
- d. God highly exalted him! Name above every name
- 3. Admonition to work out own salvation

vs 12-16

- a. No murmurings/disputings
- b. Blameless and harmless sons of God shining as lights
- c. Holding forth the word of life
- 4. Paul & Timothy's heart and example

vs 17-24

5. Epaphroditus' Service

vs 25-30

- a. Ministered to Paul for the Philippians.
- b. Sick almost unto death not regarding his own life.

- a. Desire to KNOW/WIN Christ

- 5. Call to walk as (& with) Paul

vs 15-21

- a. Perfect mindset
- b. Pressing towards the mark
- c. Not like the enemies of the cross of Christ
 - * End is destruction; god is their belly; glory in their shame; mind earthly things.
- d. Conversation in heaven ---> Hope of resurrection

1. Beseeching likemindedness amongst the brethren vs 1-3

2. Importance of Prayer and Peace

vs 4-7

- * In everything; with thanksgiving; unto God; peace keep our hearts and minds.
- 3. Importance of Focus and Meditation

vs 8-9

- * Focus on things: true, honest, just, pure, lovely, good report, virtue, praise.
- 4. Paul's Contentment

vs 10-13

- * In whatever state (abounding or being abased)
- 5. Philippi's Generosity
